## Q&A

- Q1: Can I learn both Ski and Snowboard simultaneously?
- A1: No, but you can book separated lesson at the same time.
- Q2: Should we buy lift-ticket in advance? Will we use ski-lift during the lesson?
- A2: Depending on your lever and it looks upon to instructor's judgement. Lift-ticket can buy later when you are going to use.
- Q3: Should we make appointment in advance?
- A3: Pre-booking can ensure your time and lesson as our instructors are limited.
- Q4: Once my lesson has finished, can I extend the time?
- A4: It can be arranged if there are available instructors, or go ask reception.
- Q5: Does the school stay open in bad weather?
- A5: Depending on the operation of ski-lift. We will refund you all money in case of lift closing due to adverse weather condition.
- Q6: When should I finish payment for my lesson?
- A6: Please finish 30 mins ahead of lesson, it might be cancelled if you are not in time. \*We will cancel lesson and charge penalty fee if we did't receive the tuition priorly.
- Q7: Is insurance included?
- A7: No, insurance for foreigner is not included.
- Q8: Can we take lessons with our children?
- A8: Children under 7 years-old please ask us at time of booking.
- Q9: Can we attend the group lesson?
- A9: Group lesson will teach in Japanese, applicants who cannot fully understand instruction are not allowed to attend. Even if there is an escort interpreter.
- Q10: What is the earliest and latest time that I can take lessons?
- A10: Earliest from 8:30 at morning, latest from 4 p.m. And we close at 17:00 p.m.
- Q11: Ski and Snowboard, which is easier to learn?
- A11: Basically, Ski is comparatively easier at the beginning.
- Q12: What degree can I expertise within 1 hour(a lesson)?
- A12: It varies from person to person, we cannot give a clear answer.
